



## **Ginn Sisters play to home crowd**

To mark the release, the band is hosting a free hometown album release party at 5 p.m. Saturday, July 1, in the Cozy Theatre at The Von Minden Hotel, 607 Lyons in Schulenburg.

After the show, the band will host a free CD release party at 8 p.m. at Freyburg Hall, located at the intersection of Farm-to-Market 956 and Farm-to-Market 2238, 12 miles southwest of La Grange.

The new CD includes 13 songs written by Tiffani, who sings the leads and plays guitar. She is accompanied by Brit's harmonies and her flute and melodica as well as Bradley Kopp on electric and acoustic guitars, Larry Paul Passalacqua on lead acoustic guitar, Timmy Campbell on drums and percussion, and Lindsey Greene on bass, with additional harmony vocals by their mother, Kari Ginn.
